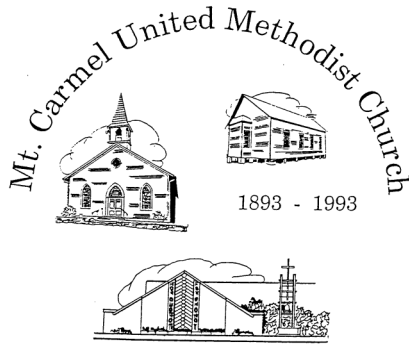

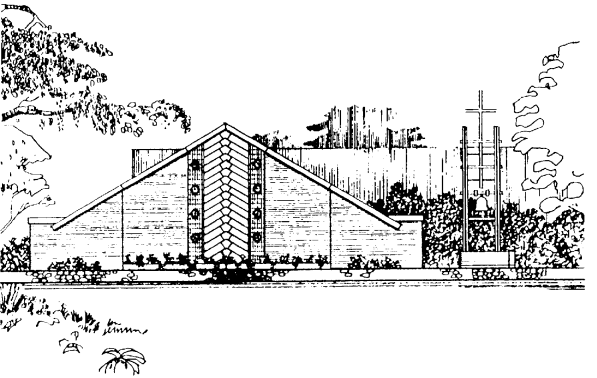

WORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Our Worship of God is central in all that we do at Mount Carmel. Our Sunday Worship services are:

- The traditional Worship service is at 10:30 a.m.
- The Early Worship Service begins at 8:30 a.m. and is contemporary in nature.
- Little's People Church (Ages 3-5 years) and Church for Children (1st Grade—3rd Grade): Our children leave the sanctuary after the Children's Time for their very own church service while their parents attend Mount Carmel's worship service.

NURSERY is provided for your babies and toddlers during Sunday School and our Worship Services.



OPPORTUNITIES TO STUDY THE BIBLE

Our Sunday School is for all ages of children, a class for Junior High Students and a class for the Senior High Students. There are a number of classes for adults.

- **United Methodist Youth Fellowship (UMYF)**

The Jr. High UMYF and the Sr. High UMYF meet usually at 5:00 p.m. each Sunday evening. They are involved in many activities and mission projects. All youth are invited.

- **Preschool Program**

Preschool meets under the direction of Jane Beeding on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday morning from 9:00 a.m. to 12 Noon. Our purpose is to provide a Christian atmosphere to enable each child to develop physically, mentally, emotionally, socially, and spiritually, to give each child loving care, and to encourage creativity and learning through a planned, age appropriate program.

- **Summer Day Camp**

During summer vacation from school, a Summer Day camp is available for boys and girls in Kindergarten through Grade 5. Activities include Bible Study, games, field trips and lots of fun.

- **Scouting**

Mount Carmel is a sponsor for all scouting programs including Brownies, Girls Scouts, Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts. The Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts meet every Monday evening at 6:30 and the Girl Scouts and Brownies meet each Tuesday at 6:30 p.m.

- **Kids in Christ (KICs)**

KIC's kids meet on the second Sunday of every month for fellowship from 3:00-5:00 p.m. They do story time, crafts, recreation, music and dinner. All children are welcome from Kindergarten through 5th Grade.

ADULT OPPORTUNITIES

- **United Methodist Men**

The UMM is a very active organization in our Church. They meet the first Sunday of each month at 7:00 a.m. for breakfast and fellowship. They have various activities throughout the year including: breakfast following the Easter Sunrise Service and a barbeque each year.

- **United Methodist Women**

The UMW is very involved in the Church through missions and Christian service. The UMW is divided into circles: Martha Thompson, Faye Kiger, and Amy Shields.

- **Music**

Music is very important here at Mount Carmel.

- ◇ Choir—Beverly Miller, Director—The choir presents special music each Sunday and special music programs throughout the year.
- ◇ Children's Choir—presents special music for our worship services and other occasions.
- ◇ Adult Bell Choir—plays several times throughout the year.

- **Wednesday Night Fellowship Dinners**

Fellowship dinners are served usually the 2nd or 3rd Wednesday of each month, hosted by one of the groups of the church. The meal and fellowship is enjoyed by all. Everyone is invited to participate. Reservations for the dinner may be made by calling the church office by noon on Tuesday.

- **Five Point Senior Citizens**

The Senior Citizens meet on the first Thursday of each month at 10:00 a.m. in our Fellowship Hall. Everyone is invited to participate. A variety of special programs are planned for each meeting.
